

Lake Luzerne Inn

The Lake Luzerne Inn stood near the road on Lake Avenue and was on Lake Luzerne. It also had two cottages from the Wayside Inn on the other side of the road. Mayor of New York City Jimmy Walker stayed in one of the cottages. The Inn had been the minister's cottage of the Estate of Mrs. Lily Price. When it was made an Inn, it had an addition added. It was a popular hotel owned by Mr. and Mrs. Tighoni and the last owners were Mr. and Mrs. Otto Cimler and Mr. and Mrs. Louis Martin. It was bought in the 1950's by Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Brunetti of Carlstad, and demolished. On the land they built the Lake Luzerne Motel and a beautiful home for themselves.
