

## Topo Maps Needed for the Northern Section of the Long Path

A total of 28 U.S.G.S. topographic maps are needed to cover all portions of the Long Path from Gilboa to Whiteface Mountain. Ten of these are in the new edition of these indispensable maps which within the past few years have been issued by the U.S. Geological Survey to cover the Adirondack Mountains. Each of these maps covers an area of about 100 square miles and come in a highly convenient folded form. The remaining 18 maps are the older, single sheets which cover half of that area but have the same scale of two inches to the mile.

The circle marking the exact center of each of the 84 Landmarks has a diameter of 2000 feet.

It is a smart move to waterproof these maps before they are taken into the field. A good coating material is available at most good map stores.

In the five parts of the Long Path Landmarks Field Guide the maps needed to cover each of these sections are listed on the center fold and should be used with a good orienteering compass.
