

### 13. Huntersland

This is a small hilltown hamlet in a deep valley east of Middleburgh. It is reached by a picturesque road which climbs the slope immediately south of the Middleburgh Cemetery. This, as with Patria on the other side of the Schoharie, is a very picturesque burying place and many fascinating glimpses into the early days of the region can be obtained by wandering through the extensive area. The view of Vroomans Nose to the west and the fertile flood plain of the Schoharie makes a magnificent picture.
