

5. Keyser Kill Falls

A few miles upstream of the tiny village of Breakabeen is beautiful Keyser Kill Falls. The Keyser Kill flows from the rugged hills lining the eastern side of the Schoharie Valley. Its cold waters harbor speckled trout and the plunge pool at the foot of the falls has been a favorite swimming hole for several hundreds of years.

As is the case of the upper Schoharie, the rock of the region consists of the Hamilton Shales and Sandstone.
