17. Cole Hill Forest This forest is the farthest east of the artridge Run State Forest. The view of the airy country to the North is very attractive. When the abandoned farms were being ssembled during the Great Depression there ere other farms east of the Cole Hill Forest hich would have been ideal for a further xtension. In the early Thirties this region as a favorite hiking area of the Mohawk alley Hiking Club and at that time it was alled The Hill of the Angel Wings because of he presence in the local rock stratae of a eautiful fossil shell having wide "wings" in ts structure. These were a type specimen in he Hamilton Beds of the region.
