

19. Tarrytown Stone Houses

The Long Path after leaving the Hannacroix Ravine Landmark continues south and easterly to a spur which leads to the village of Clarksville and then continues southerly to Tarrytown. This place has a number of early and picturesque limestone houses. Nearby is an old cemetery and a fine limestone Reformed Church typical of an old Dutch settlement. A limestone cave is located in a field nearby into which the outlet of Lawson's Lake flows. This stream again reaches the surface as a tributary of the Onesquethaw Creek.
