1. Helderberg Ridge A long north-south ridge which in its entral region is called Countryman's Hill. ts northern end has Camp Pinnacle and a umber of television towers. The road slopes ownward and intersects the Beaver Dam Road. This limestone ridge consists of a core f limestone in which has been found some agnificent fossils of the ancient Devonian eas. Especially noteworthy are a series of arge trilobites found in the early days of eology of the 1800's. The Helderberg imestone fossils are known worldwide for heir sequence from the Silurian to the evonian and were studied in great detail by he early geologists and paleontologists ssociated with the Geological Survey headed y Dr. James Hall.
