7. Duanesburg The small town of Duanesburg was founded y James Duane who owned a large acreage of and centered around his little settlement. t was located on the Western Turnpike one of he first major roads connecting Buffalo with lbany. Great quantities of farm produce were arried along this road and some of the mkany averns built for the travelers still remain. , This town is the last place along the ong Path where provisions can be obtained ntil the hiker reaches the Mohawk River at otterdam Junction.
