8. Featherstonhaugh Lake This small lake is on State Land and is good camping spot for the trek between Itamont and Rotterdam Junction. It was acquired by the State some years go. This pond was named after a family who nce owned it and was part of the large area f land acquired by James Duane who had dreams f making Duanesburg one of the leading rading centers in the Northeast. With the dvent of the Erie Canal in 1825 and the New ork Central Railroad not long after, the reat Western Turnpike which brought trade to uanesburg became less important and Albany. chenectady and Troy began to grow and ominate the region.
