32. Mabie House (1670)

At the place near Rotterdam Junction where the Mohawk-Hudson Bike Path crosses New York State Route 5S about a half mile west of the Plotter Kill Aqueduct if the road is followed another half mile west at a place west of the plant of the Schenectady Chemical Plant will be found the ancient Mabie House. Built before 1670 by Marte Van Antwerpen and purchased from him by Jan Mabie at that time this stone house with its steep roof and small dormers has been beautifully preserved. A nearby structure having its doors suspended with classic Dutch Hinges. It may have been used as a small tavern since a very picturesque tavern sign was found about 20 years ago.
