

35. Green Corners School

As the Wolf Hollow Road goes northerly it intersects Potter Road and the Toureuna Road at a crossroads called Green Corners. Within sight of this spot on Potter Road can be seen a brick, one-room schoolhouse utilized for a century or more in teaching the local farm children.

The efficacy of this type of education, probably also reflecting the dedication of the teachers who held forth over the years, is attested by a number of children who went on to become outstanding citizens. One of these is Clarence Van der Veer who until he died recently lived in the family homestead along Toureuna Road. Clarence hated farm work especially milking cows! He was a highly competent historian, photographer and inventor. One of his many hobbies was the collection of beautiful quartz crystals from the limestone of the region.
