44. Great Kame A few miles up river from Northville after crossing the bridge on the left hand side of Route 30 is a huge glacial Kame which is being mined for construction sand and gravel. It is opposite the mouth of the East Stony Creek which probably had a lobe of the Continental Glacier that flowed across the eastern Adirondacks. The valley of the West Stony Creek which ..... Cen
