

52. Round Lake
This is one of the several Round Ponds in the Adirondacks and as usual is not at all round! Its rocky, indented shores are quite beautiful and since it is all state land the area provides many fine camping spots. Trails lead to the Lake from the Garnet Lake - Thurman Road and from Garnet Lake. This latter body of water is considerably larger than it was before it was converted by a log dam into a mill pond. It is likely that the trail from Baldwin Springs was on dry land before the dam was built and that the military road went along the east side of the present lake.
