52. Round Lake This is one of the several Round Ponds in the Adirondacks and as usual is not at all round! Its rocky, indented shores are quite beautiful and since it is all state land the area provides many fine camping spots. Trails lead to the Lake from the Garnet Lake -Thurman Road and from Garnet Lake. latter body of water is considerably larger than it was before it was converted by a log lam into a mill pond. It is likely that the crail from Baldwin Springs was on dry land pefore the dam was built and that the military coad went along the east side of the present lake.
