54a. The Cannon Place This was the site where a fine swivel gun of the type which was probably used by Benedict Arnold during the Battle of Valcour Island was found about twenty years ago. A fown of Johnsburg road crew planning to straighten a "dog leg" on the Johnsburg-Garnet .ake Road was removing some ancient corduroy logs which once carried the road across the wamp. One of the workers noticed the little annon as one of the logs was removed. It was ighteen inches long, 4 inches in diameter at the large end of the taper, was made of cast ron and had a bore of one inch. It was in Mountain perfect condition except for the brackets hich presumably had been destroyed when the un was "killed" as it was abandoned. This as done by pointing the gun vertically and hooting a charge. The recoil effectively roke off the brackets. The gun had a black atina and was not at all rusty. It is now in he possession of a grandson of the finder. W448
