5. Crystalline Limestone At the place where the Elliott Putnam load meets the Garnet Lake-Johnsburg Road is large "finger" of crystalline limestone. It s one of the finest exposures bordering a oad in the Adirondacks. At one time the town ighway department planned to straighten the ighway but after drilling a number of bore oles decided to leave the rock alone. A hort distance farther north along this rock xposure a seam of Serendibite was discovered. his is an extremely rare mineral found only n a few places worldwide -- one of the other laces being the Island of Ceylon which once as called Serendip. (From this comes the ord Serendipity coined by Sir Horace Walpole ho described the travels of the Three Princes f Serencip as being replete with fortunate ccidents..)
