

62. North Creek Village

At the mouth of North Creek, a cold trout stream which enters the Hudson River at the small village of that name the through hiker can replenish provisions. A number of excellent stores can be found along Main Street where just about anything can be purchased at reasonable prices. Since once the Hudson is crossed and the Long Path corridor is followed northwesterly, there are no more provision points until Newcomb is reached which is at least several days away to the North.

North Creek was the destination of the first New York Snow Train which arrived there on March 4, 1934. Skiers from the Schenectady Wintersports Club were deeply involved in establishing the Gore Mountain Ski Center at North Creek nearly sixty years ago.
