

70. Newcomb Lake

This is a beautiful wild lake which once was part of an extensive land holding of Robert Pruyn of Albany, New York, who built a very elaborate Great Camp on the shores of the Lake. Mount Santanoni (Saint Anthony) dominates the skyline to the northwest. It was donated to the State of New York about years ago. At present an effort is being made to find a valid use for the many well preserved buildings of this complex.

The next Landmark may require a considerable bushwhack to reach the upper drainage of the Hudson River in the vicinity of Tahawus Mine. The traveler is warned against traveling alone in this very wild country.
