82. Whiteface Mountain Summit The summit of Whiteface Mountain is the terminus of the Long Path of New York. It can be reached by the open slopes of the Whiteface Mountain Ski Center, by climbing one of the several rock scars where the thin soil covering the mountain has peeled away after a series of torrential rains or by a mountain trail which originates on Marble Mountain and eventually reaches the summit. The easiest and most open of these routes would follow one of the ski trails originating near the summit.
