

# **RAILWAY HISTORY**

**Heritage Corridor** 





The First Wilderness Heritage Corridor in the Adirondack Mountains of New York State, follows the Upper Hudson River Valley from Saratoga Springs to Tahawus and first served as a hunting ground for the Indian people who had established trails connecting the Mohawk Valley to the Champlain Valley. Soldiers followed these same trails during the French and Indian War (1755). After fighting had subsided, large tracks of land were awarded for military service, and settlers began the establishments of the new of hamlets, villages and townships in Warren County.

The construction of a rail system by W. C. Durant after the Civil War led way to the easy access for




tourism vacationers that would stay as large hotels and resorts in the Saratoga and Hadley/ Luzerne area. The fur trading, logging, tanning and mining industries

soon captured the economy in most of these waterfront communities from Corinth to North Creek and beyond.

The late 1930's and 40's, dude ranches and resorts grew in popularity as destinations for country adventure. Routes 9N and 9 became the main arteries from Manhattan to Montreal.






