Based on the location of Library Avenue, it does not appear that flooding is a major concern for the proposed project. To the extent practicable, the proposed project will be sited, designed and constructed to prevent and minimize damage associated with future sealevel rise, storm surge and flooding. Project engineers and design will consider use of resiliency measures that utilize natural resources and natural processes, including constructed stormwater green infrastructure, to reduce risk posed by climatic hazards. Consideration of potential effects will include, but not be limited to, impact of diverted floodwaters onto adjacent properties; contamination of surface or ground waters; obstruction of natural sediment transport and increased erosion of, or risk of damage to, adjacent built or natural areas. Additionally, interagency, community and stakeholder collaboration will be utilized during project development.
