The existing children play area / playground at Usher's Park is well outdated, and is underutilized and almost unsafe. Many times, visitors to the park do not bother utilizing the playground since it is very limited in recreational amenity or variety for different age groups. Many municipal parks in the area have been upgrading their playground and child play areas to accommodate ADA accessibility, all age groups, and to provide for newer, more interactive amenities to enjoy.

The upgrading of the playground to incorporate the proposed "Pirate Ship" as well as some other recreational amenities for the 2 yrs and under, 2-5 yrs and 5-11 yrs age groups, would enhance the appearance and overall use of the park, and allow for more residents and visitors to bring their children to the play area, which they may not have done before due to limited opportunity.
