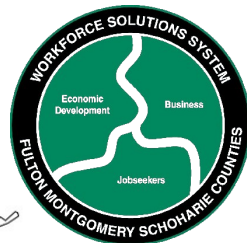
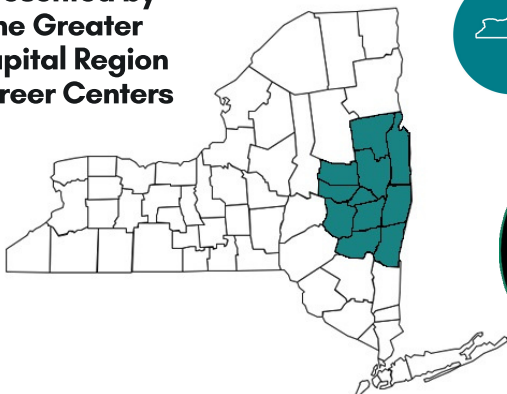
INTERVIEW PREPARATION

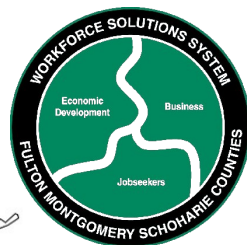
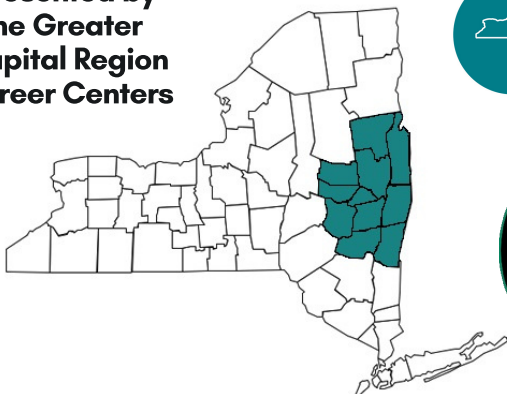
TRANSFERRABLE SKILLS

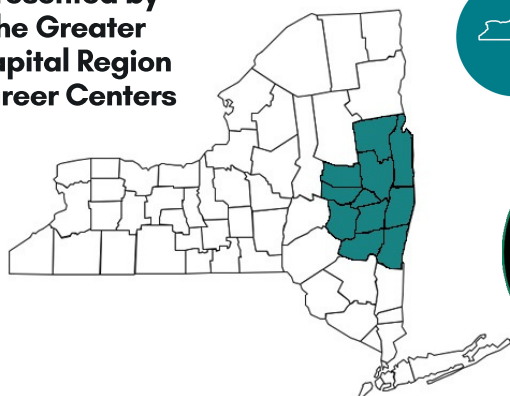
