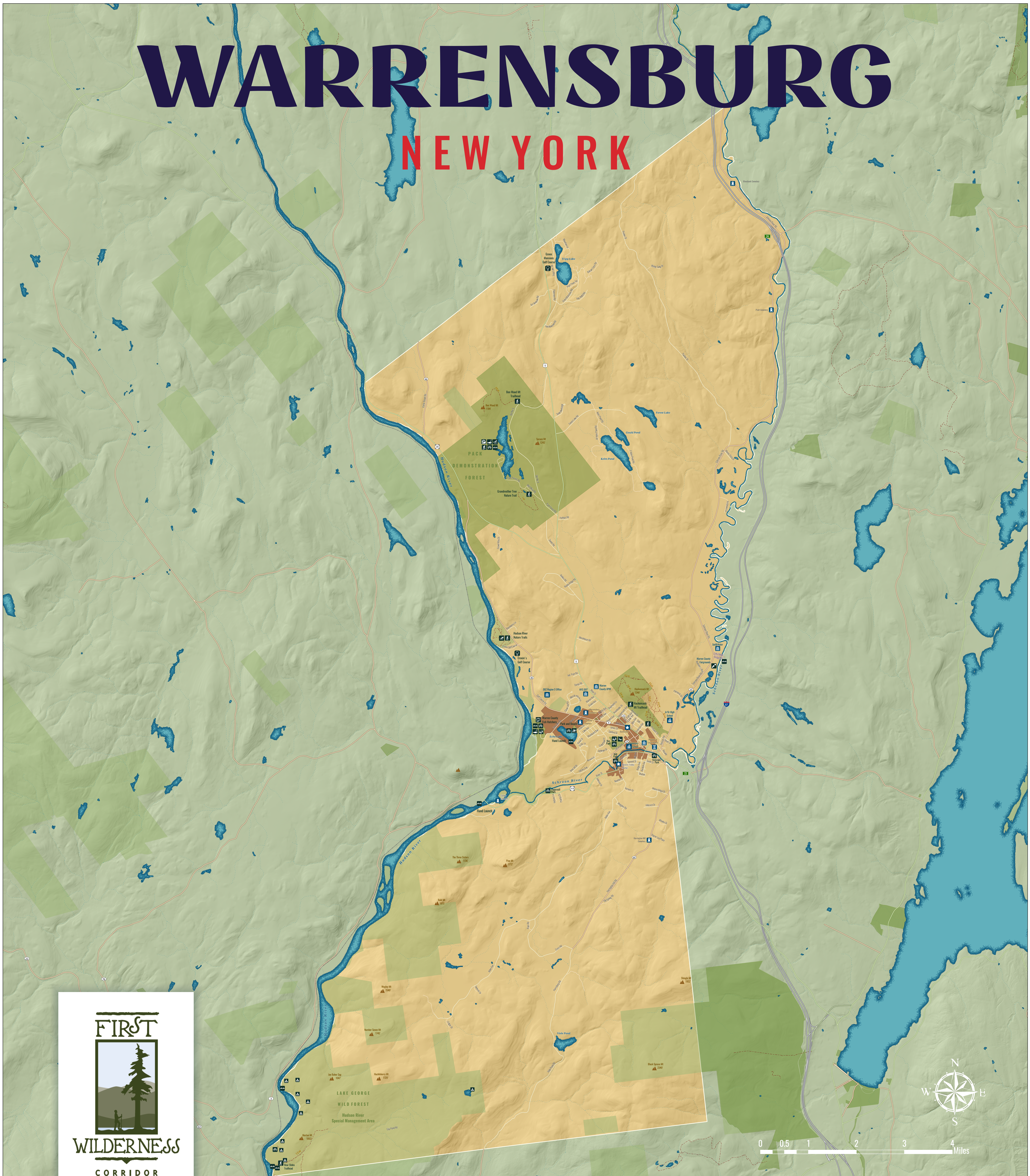

Hardscrabble farming was the mainstay of the Warrensburg economy when it was formed from the Town of Thurman in 1813. Then its strategic location at the intersection of the Schroon and Hudson rivers made it an ideal site for saw mills, grist mills, tanning and related industries. Lumbering and potash production were important, as was the garment industry in later years. The National Register of Historic Places has recognized Warrensburg as a historic district with more than 60 notable buildings and structures.
