Located in north Hague on the west side of Lake George, Rogers Rock State Campground is beloved by families and steeped in history. The campground is named after Robert Rogers, an American frontiersman who slipped through the fingers of pursuing Native Americans by sliding down the steep face of what is now called Rogers Rock during the French and Indian War. Campers have plenty to do at this facility, including swimming, bicycling, fishing, boating, and hiking on state marked trails.

Anchors Aweigh!

Boating in Lake George is the ultimate summer freedom. Boaters spend their days following the wooded shoreline, dropping anchor in secluded bays, basking in the sun under cloudless skies, learning to waterski or tossing castafter-cast for a lunker of a fish. Launch your own boat from the town park or rent a boat from one of the marinas in town.



Dive in

Stay in one of Hague's many vacation cottages, inns and lodges along Lake George and enjoy their beautiful lakefront beaches, or visit Hague's town beach marked with an American flag. It offers the same stunning views and refreshing waters as its neighbors to the south, in a much more peaceful setting.

On the Waterfront

Explore life at your own pace in Hague, overlooking the broad expanse of Lake George's north basin where fleets of sailboats race all summer and powerboats tow tubers and skiers. In autumn, the beauty of Lake George is enhanced by the magnificent colors of fall foliage. After the lake freezes, skaters, snowmobilers and ice fisherman enjoy the snow and cold.

Life's a Picnic

Hague's town park, boat launch and sandy beach offer a scenic and comfortable spot for families to picnic and enjoy the water, sheltered by the Waltonian group of craggy islands. Town-sponsored concerts bring the community together in the park each week during the summer.


