

Indian Pond Trail

Thurman, New York



Indian Pond



Difficulty: Easy
Length: 1.8 mi roundtrip
Time to Complete: 1-2 hours
Trailhead Coordinates: -74.065, 43.481
Trail Notes: This trail travels through a beautiful old pine forest for a little under a mile where it reaches the remains of an old dam on a shallow pond with a campsite for overnight stays.

Directions and Parking: Take the Northway to Exit 23. Turn left off the exit and then turn right onto US9. Continue on US9 for approximately 0.5mi. Turn left onto Richards Ave and then turn right onto NY-418. Continue on NY-418 for approximately 3.5mi. Stay straight to continue on Stony Creek Rd/Warrensburg Rd until you get to Stony Creek. Turn right onto Harrisburg Rd and continue for approximately 5.3mi. Turn right onto Wolf Pond Rd and then left onto West Stony Creek Rd. Continue for approximately 4.8mi to the trailhead and parking on your left.

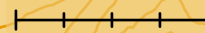
