

Kibby Pond Trail

Johnsburg, New York

Difficulty:

Easy

Length:

2.6 miles roundtrip

Time to Complete:

2-3 hours

Trailhead Coordinates:

-74.103, 43.578

Trail Notes:

This relatively easy hike crosses a beautiful brook, then heads up a moderate climb to the shore of pretty Kibby Pond. The trail may be muddy in spots and requires scrambling over a few downed trees, but it is well-marked and easy to follow. One campsite is located right at the trail's end and another can be found just a short distance south.

Directions and Parking:

Take the Northway to Exit 23. Turn west on Diamond Point Rd and then right onto US9 North for 4.2 mi. Turn left onto NY-28N South and continue for 10.7 mi. Turn left onto NY-8 South and continue for 11.5 mi. The trailhead, with a small sign that may be easily missed, is on the left. Parking is along the road.
