


Oregon Trail to Stewart Creek Flow

Thurman and Johnsburg, New York



Difficulty: Easy
Length: 1.6 mi roundtrip
Time to Complete: 1 hour
Trailhead Coordinates: -74.145, 43.529
Trail Notes: This short trail is a lovely (albeit muddy in spots) walk to a pretty waterfall and the site of an old dam. You can end your hike at Stewart Creek Flow, where a snowmobile bridge crosses the creek, or continue on the trail to North Bend and Baldwin Springs. The area around the creek is generally abundant with wildflowers and is an excellent spot for birdwatching.

Directions and Parking: Take the Northway to Exit 23. Turn west on Diamond Point Rd and then right onto US9 North for 4.2mi. Turn left onto NY-28N South and continue for 10.7mi. Turn left onto NY-8 South and continue for 14.9mi. The trailhead, with a small sign that may be easily missed, and a parking lot for 10-12 cars, is on the left.
