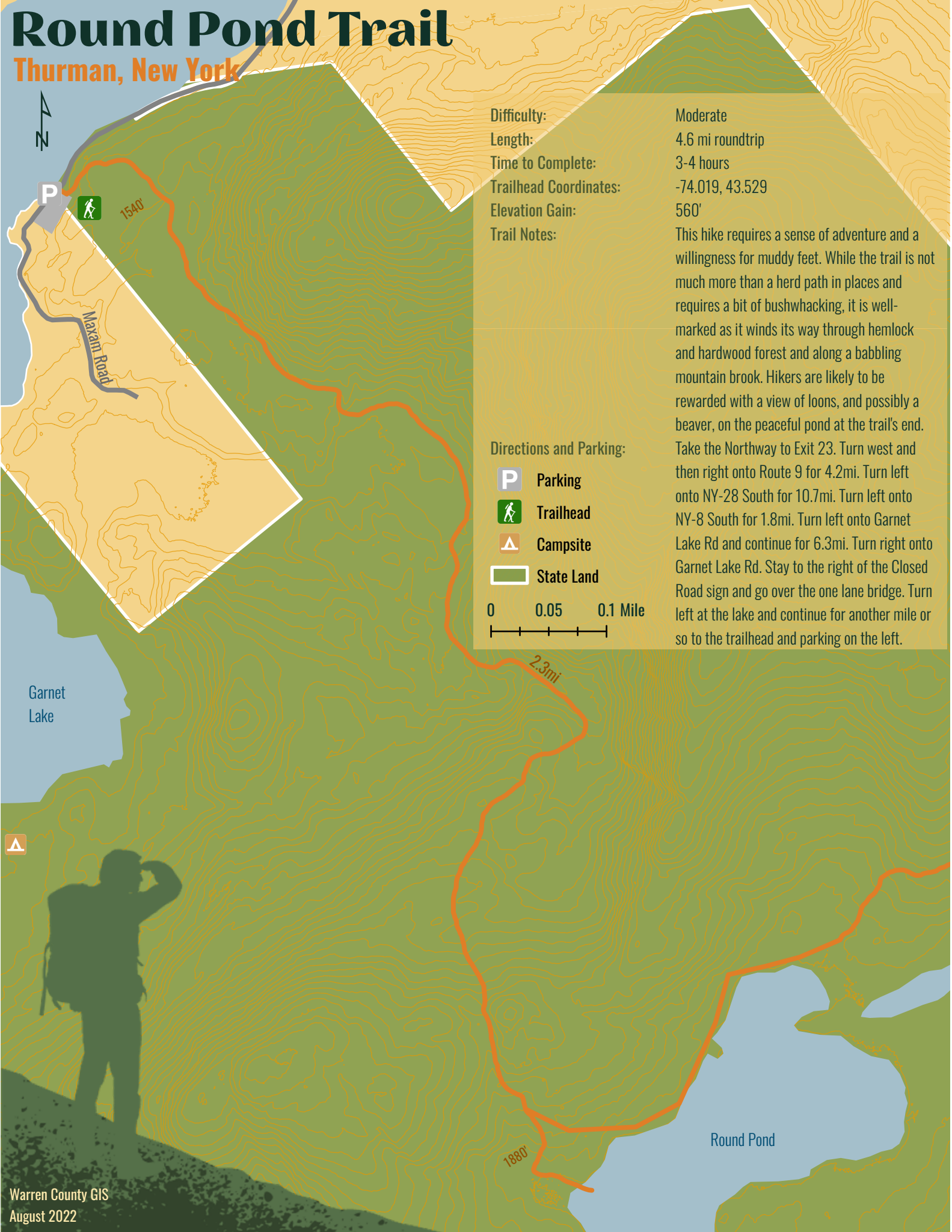


Round Pond Trail

Thurman, New York



Difficulty: Moderate
Length: 4.6 mi roundtrip
Time to Complete: 3-4 hours
Trailhead Coordinates: -74.019, 43.529
Elevation Gain: 560'
Trail Notes: This hike requires a sense of adventure and a willingness for muddy feet. While the trail is not much more than a herd path in places and requires a bit of bushwhacking, it is well-marked as it winds its way through hemlock and hardwood forest and along a babbling mountain brook. Hikers are likely to be rewarded with a view of loons, and possibly a beaver, on the peaceful pond at the trail's end. Take the Northway to Exit 23. Turn west and then right onto Route 9 for 4.2mi. Turn left onto NY-28 South for 10.7mi. Turn left onto NY-8 South for 1.8mi. Turn left onto Garnet Lake Rd and continue for 6.3mi. Turn right onto Garnet Lake Rd. Stay to the right of the Closed Road sign and go over the one lane bridge. Turn left at the lake and continue for another mile or so to the trailhead and parking on the left.
