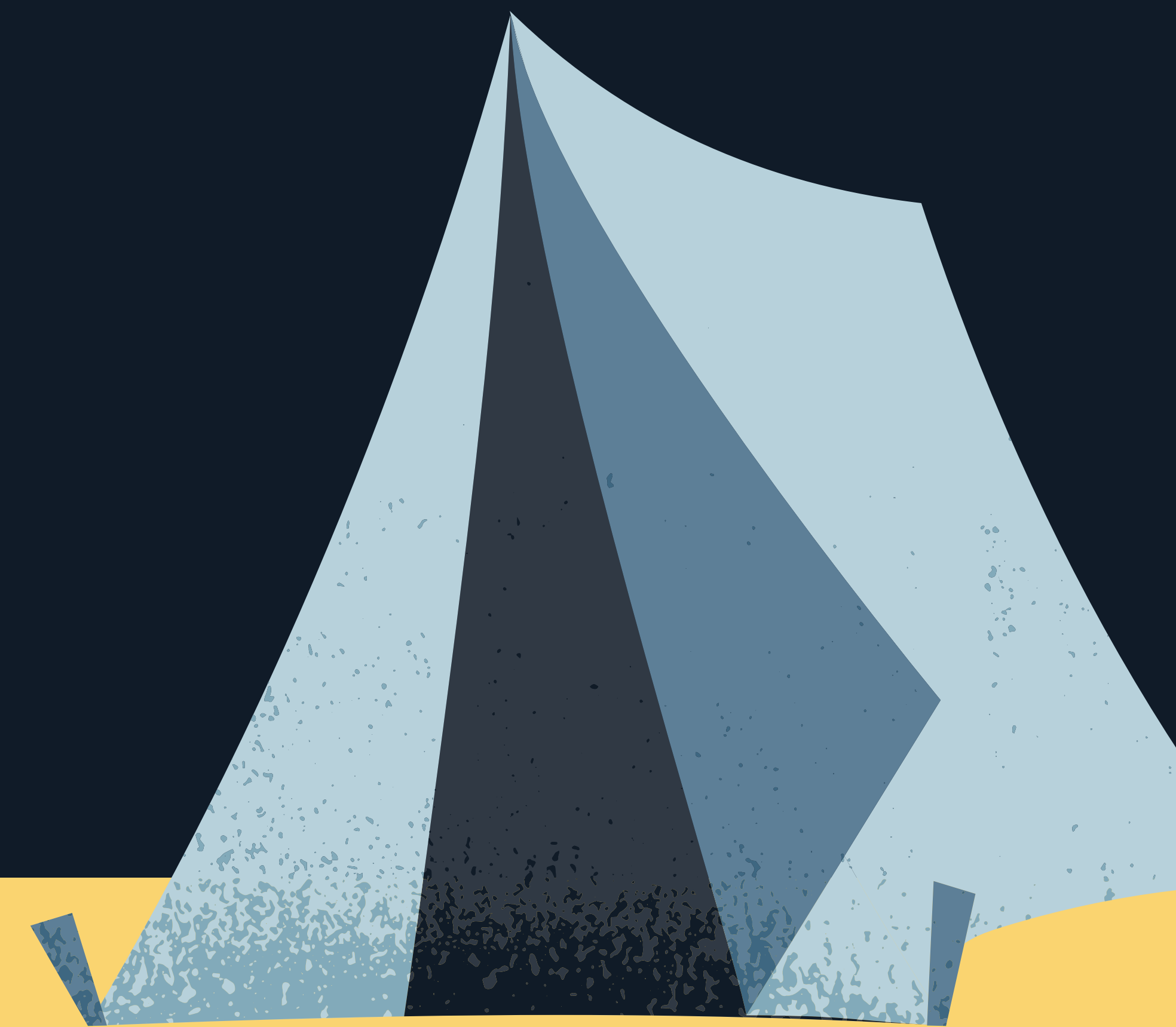

Fish On!

With numerous lakes, ponds and streams feeding into the Hudson River, Thurman has an abundance of fishing opportunities, including many small trout streams and ponds that are strategically stocked and monitored. Thurman's portion of the Hudson is a favorite destination for anglers pursuing bass, northern pike, catfish and even the occasional walleye.



Maple Days

Dubbed the "Maple Capital" of Warren County, Thurman is home to five commercial maple farms and host of one of Upstate New York's largest Maple Festivals, when it drips in sticky-sweet maple goodness annually over three weekends in March. Maple producers open their sugar houses to the public, inviting locals and visitors alike to sample their products, learn from their techniques, and share in their maple mania.

Down on the Farm

Thurman is home to numerous family farms featuring heritage pigs, grass-fed cattle, Icelandic sheep, vegetables, all natural poultry and eggs, internationally awarded goat cheese and ice cream, maple products, and trees. Many of the farms are open to visitors throughout the year, as well as during the spring Maple Days and Fall Farm Tour, held annually in October.
