Hackensack Mt can be hiked as a short out and back to the summit from the trailhead on Hackensack Ave, or combined into a loop up and over the summit from Prospect St and around the backside on the purple trail. The relatively flat yellow trails wander through the

Directions and Parking:

There are two trailheads: one on Hackensack Ave and one on Prospect St. For the Prospect St trailhead, take the Northway to Exit 23. Turn left and then right onto US9. Continue 0.7 miles and turn right on Horicon Ave. Follow hiking signs and turn left on Pratt St, right on Terrace, and left on Prospect. The trailhead and parking area is on the right. The Hackensack Ave trailhead is a right hand turn 1.4 miles after the turn onto Route 9, and the trailhead is on the right. Parking is on street at the intersection of Hackensack and Warren Avenues.
