Cost of Non-Secure Detention In 2008: \$245.83 Per Day

Cost of Institution: \$80,300-122,000 Per Year

Cost of Tuition: Average \$38,000 Per Year

Non Secure Detention Savings Per 2008 Dollars (2003 vs 2008): $\$226,655 - 42,529 = \$184,126$

Institution Savings Per 2008 Dollars (2003 vs 2008) : \$1,064,000 to \$1,440,000

Electronic Monitoring has served 144 youth as of 12/31/08.

(2) Youth Court (FFFS)

Youth Court is a major referral source for Probation Intake. Ct. is held in Queensbury & Warrensburg. Hold offenders accountable & reestablish themselves as contributing members of the community.

(3) Psychological Assessments (FFFS)

Contract for psychological assessments of PINS youth at Probation

PINS Crisis Interv./Respite & Truancy Prevention (State PINS Detention Prevention) *SY (Secure Youth) SD (Secure Days)

Contract with Youth Advocate Program & Homeless Youth Coalition for crisis

(4) Preventive/Probation Contract (64/36%)

DSS & Probation developed a Prev contract to assist with the expanding PINS 16-18 population
It has (1) Probation Officer & a DSS Case Supervisor attends Drug Treatment Court

(5) Electronic Monitoring (State PINS Det. Prev)

In an effort to reduce detention & subsequent placement admissions DSS contracted for E-Monitoring services in 2004. Probation & Family Ct. now have alternative to detention.
