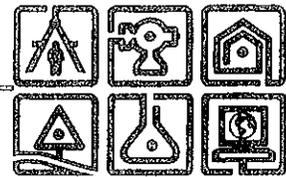

As requested, C.T. Male Associates, P.C. (C.T.
