I. Planning Committee Chairman - Meeting called to order.

II. Motion to approve minutes of prior Planning Committee Meeting.

III. Items for Planning Committee Action:

a.) Request Resolution to submit an application for funding to the NYS Housing Trust Fund Corporation for funding to undertake project planning under the 2010 Community Planning Program. The grant requested would not exceed \$40,000 and the Plan to be developed would result in the identification and collection of information for potential eligible projects under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The application is required to identify future, eligible CDBG projects that meet priority criteria of the NYS Housing Trust Fund Corporation at the Office of Community Renewal. The application submission date is Monday, July 19, 2010.

b.) Request Resolution to Ratify Contract Amendment for the Quadracentennial Grant awarded to Warren County for local communities. (Amendment extends contract to December 31, 2010).

IV. Old Business and Pending Items:

a.) Vacancy on the Warren County Planning Board representing the Town of Warrensburg. (The Town Supervisor is aware of the vacancy and is searching for a representative.)

b.) Meeting at Up Yonda Farm in Bolton with Matt Sprow. (Scheduling conflicts have delayed the meeting to date. The Planning Director and Assistant Director are intending on meeting with Matt on the week of June 27th.)

V. Discussion Items and Updates:

a.) First Wilderness Corridor Plan Implementation - Update regarding the activities of the newly hired Event Technical Assistance Provider funded by the NYS DOS Local Waterfront Revitalization Program award to Warren County.

b.) GIS and Mapping Projects: Planning staff is working with IT to replace the GIS server that was intended to be replaced in 2009. While efforts have been taken to extend the current server through memory expansion, a number of processing and access issues have been occurring and cannot be corrected. The Department will replace the existing server and funds are available within the Department's budget to acquire this equipment. The Planning Director has had discussions with the County Attorney's Office concerning the billing process for the Towns and is researching options for proceeding. Information is attached concerning the Spatial Data Viewer Survey. The Department developed 2 analysis maps for the Glens Falls Office of Community Development that details Census information and residential property distribution by type for the Wards 1 and 3.





Residency of Users:




Frequency of Usage:








SDV USE FOR TOURISM
