Group Tour:

- Solicitation for the 2011 Group Tour Planner was distributed to 300+ properties June 3rd with a July 2nd deadline. New for this year! All ads in the planner will be designed in full color. New additions will include a glossy cover, lighter stock inside pages and new features such as a "What's New" page and new itineraries to include a "Locally Grown and Crafted" Tour. Cost for a full page ad is \$250.00 and 3,500 planners expected to be printed. Printing bids will go out on July 1st, 2010.
- Assisting in the coordination and promotion of the 3rd annual Adirondack Region Virtual Familiarization tour to be presented online to Tour Operators on September 22, 2010. The "E-Fam" will consist of a 30 minute overview of the Adirondack Region and sample itineraries showcasing Plattsburg, Lake Placid and Lake George. To promote the Fam Tour an invitation postcard will be inserted in the July/August issue of Group Tour Magazine.

Confirmed Events:

- It has been confirmed as of last week that 1,300 riders are pre-registered for Velo Quebec's Grand Tour, August 7-13th. According to event organizers, we can expect to see a surge of registrants in July. Velo Quebec estimates total attendee numbers to be 2,000+.
- Assistance needed with volunteers for The Grand Tour. (See attached)
- Final site meeting at ACC will be set up for July to coordinate the breakfast set up with local caterers and to familiarize event set up representatives with the ACC campus.
- Two 3x9 banners designed for the ACC Campus to welcome riders have been produced.
- A press release will be issued to local media one week prior to the event to publicize routes and times riders will be on local roads in Queensbury, Hague, Horicon and Chester.
- NYS District Attorney's Association: Providing assistance with a hospitality exhibit and welcome bags for the summer conference to be held July 8-11th at the Sagamore.

Potential Future Events:

- Met a contact for BMW Motorcycle Owners of America at the tourism booth display Holiday Inn during Americade and the organization has interest in our area for a potential 2013 or 2014 rally in mid July. This year's 38th annual rally will take place in Redmond, Oregon. Preliminary discussions will continue after completion of this year's rally as to whether we can meet this groups needs for outdoor and indoor exhibit space as well as room requirements. Room requirements are 3,000 as well as an unspecified amount of camping sites for those traveling in RV's.

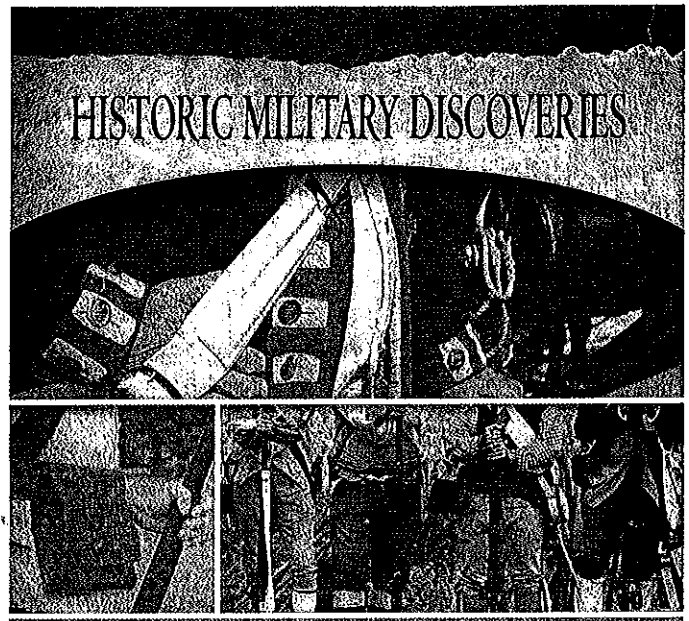

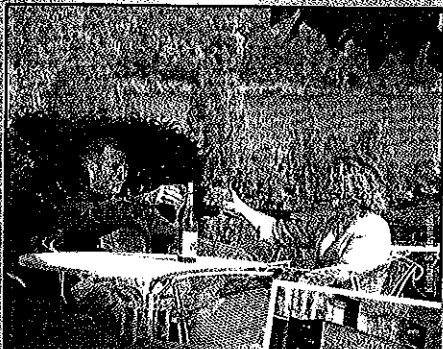

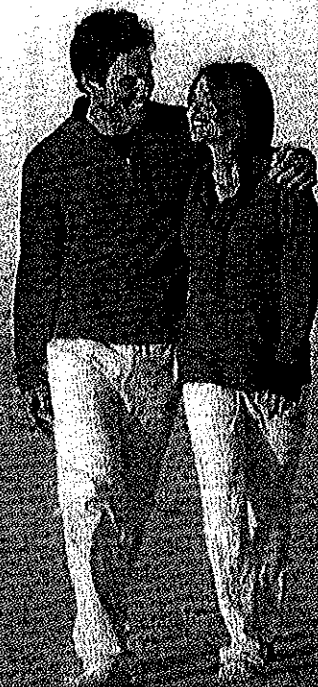
