Dear Honorable Hogan:

It is my pleasure to inform you that the New York State Office of Victim Services (OVS) has awarded your program a one-year extension to your current contract for the period October 1, 2012 to September 30, 2013. OVS has received its federal award for 2012 and it is 12% less than last year's award. However, while OVS' award has been cut significantly, we are able to manage our resources such that awards to Victim Assistance Programs only have to be reduced by 2%. OVS is able to provide your organization an annual award for 2012-13 in the amount of **\$118,451**. As always, the award remains dependent on the availability of federal VOCA funds and state appropriations.

All other terms and conditions of your current executed contract will remain in full force and effect. This extension may only support services and activities which were the basis for your original award and the scope may not be modified. Additionally, the Simplified Renewal provides for the option of an additional one-year extension making the dates for this Renewal October 1, 2009 to September 30, 2014. OVS will make a decision about an additional extension late in 2012.

Enclosed with this letter is a copy of the Simplified Renewal Agreement which must be signed, notarized, and received, with the other required documents, in our office by **2:00 pm on Monday, June 18, 2012**. Late submissions will not be accepted and your contract with OVS will end on September 30, 2012.
