

WHEREAS, the eradication and treatment of each has led to the investment of several thousand dollars, and


WHEREAS, we depend on our lake to support our tourism industry, our economy and our drinking water, and

WHEREAS, we must take immediate steps to reverse the infestation and support the work with an identified, guaranteed revenue stream.

WE, the Village Board of Trustees, of the Village of Lake George do hereby support mandatory inspection of all boats entering the waters of Warren County lakes from other areas.

OFFER Village property to erect at least one "Wash Station", and

URGE Commissioners to raise boat registration fees and Warren County to consider a ½ of 1% increase in sales tax to cover the creation and annual expenses of such wash stations and expenses related to the containment and eradication of invasive species in all Warren County lakes.
