- Composition
- Staffing
- Calls for service
- Arrests

Through a careful analysis of the G.F.P.D. 2012 statistics and an interview of Glens Falls Police Chief William Valenza, the following assessments and determinations were made. In order to provide a consistent level of police services to the City of Glens Falls the following increases in staffing would need to be implemented at the Warren County Sheriff's Office:

- (16) additional Patrol Officers
- (4) additional Sergeants
- (2) additional Investigators
- (1) additional Lieutenant
