VOLUNTEERS

- 150+ volunteers from all 8 school districts/10 communities eligible to participate
- 106 have participated in the last year
 - 3 offenders completed training
 - 78 would be considered active, having attended 6 or more sessions throughout the year (includes training sessions)
- Youth Court Immersion
 - 9 volunteers overnight
 - Production of new jury training video
 - Funded by Warren County Bar - additional award

COMMUNITY SERVICE

- youth have provided service to approximately 36 organizations/municipalities across 7 communities
 - Bolton Landing
 - Chestertown
 - Glens Falls
 - Hague
 - Lake George
 - North Creek
 - Queensbury
 - Thurman
 - Warrensburg
- more than 75 service opportunities, majority of which were open to all youth (offenders and volunteers)
- more than 2,500 hours of service completion
