

- (b) Details: **The DPW Parks and Recreation Division has provided fish to many municipalities and educational NFP organizations over the past several decades. This resolution would authorize the Superintendent of Public Works to provide such fish under the following conditions:**
  - 1) Sufficient inventory of fish exists for annual stocking needs**
  - 2) the request is for 500 fish or less**
  - 3) there will be no cost to the County for transport of fish**
  - 4) all NYSDEC permits are obtained, when required**
  - 5) requesting agency is verified as municipality or educational not for profit organization**

NYS Snowmobile Registrations since 1991





Final approvals to be provided subsequent to a review of final construction documents and proof of liability insurance with limits not less than \$2 million per occurrence/\$6 million aggregate.
