
- 1) Committee to investigate the possibility of making County campuses smoke free. (09.01.15)

4. NEAREST EXISTING UTILITIES (UNDERGROUND AND OVERGROUND) SHALL BE MAINTAINED & PROTECTED THROUGHOUT THE PERIOD OF CONSTRUCTION. USE OF CONCRETE SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PROTECT ALL UTILITIES.
5. NEAREST EXISTING UTILITIES SHALL BE MAINTAINED & PROTECTED THROUGHOUT THE PERIOD OF CONSTRUCTION. USE OF CONCRETE SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PROTECT ALL UTILITIES.
