

- ▣ 1995 Began service with a County Wide ALSFR Certificate of Operation.
- ▣ 2000 Began Hiring EMTs to staff local volunteer ambulances during daytime shortages.
- ▣ 2009 Received an Ambulance Certificate of Operation . Started answering calls as a back-up agency to volunteers who could not get crews or had multiple calls.
- ▣ 2016 Assumed our first district providing primary EMS.
