The New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services Office of Public Safety is in the process of completing a comprehensive review and update of the Municipal Police Training Council's (MPTC) Basic Course for Police Officers. During the September 2017 MPTC meeting the Council approved significant changes to the 40 hour Interpersonal Skills and Arrest Techniques (Defensive Tactics) curriculum and established new instructor requirements to enhance the minimum training standards for new police officers. These changes also impact the training of peace officers at both the basic level and required annual weapons training. The following is a summary of the changes made to the defensive tactics curriculum and an overview of the implementation plan for instructors to meet the new defensive tactics requirements.

Overview of Changes

The Interpersonal Skills and Arrest Techniques section will be re-named Defensive Tactics and Principles of Control and will focus solely on 40 hours of physical defensive tactics. Content on communication, active shooter, aerosol subject restraint, and crowd and riot control formations, which were previously part of the old curriculum, have been removed and are now either standalone sections or have been incorporated into existing sections of instruction. Additional information regarding the sections that have been removed from the defensive tactics curriculum, including hours, instructor requirements and a link to download the new materials will be provided in a forthcoming memo.

A significant change in the new Defensive Tactics and Principles of Control curriculum is the revision of instructional objectives that focus solely on a principle based defensive tactics approach. The move to principle based tactics, which are simplified and reduced in number, will provide recruits with improved methodology and ability to learn in an effort to master hands on tactics while in the training environment.

To ensure current DCJS approved defensive tactics instructors are familiarized with the new instructional objectives, the MPTC is requiring all current defensive tactics instructors to complete the Defensive Tactics Two Day Refresher Course. Completion of this training is required in order to receive approval to instruct the new curriculum. This course will cover the new principles as well as practical exercises involving new tactics.

Implementation Requirements of New Curriculum for Police and Peace Basic Training

Recognizing the change to the curriculum and the need to meet the new instructor requirement has wide implications across both police and peace officer training; DCJS has created an implementation plan for academies and agencies to meet these new requirements. The plan involves a sustainable model whereby current DCJS approved instructors that successfully complete the required two-day refresher training will be approved to instruct the same two-day refresher training to other DT instructors in their agency and surrounding jurisdictions. To further assist trainers to meet this new instructor requirement, there will be a series of two-day refreshers conducted regionally across New York State. Finally, there will be required dates for police and peace officers – as outlined below – to begin using the new curriculum instructed by trainers who have met the new requirement.

Police Officer Training Implementation

Basic Course for Police Officers or equivalent and Specialized Investigator Police Training Course

All training academies and agencies submitting course curricula for approval to conduct a Basic Course for Police Officers (or equivalent) or a Specialized Investigator Police Training Course that would begin after January 1, 2018 must utilize the new Defensive Tactics and Principles of Control curriculum. Instruction must also be provided by a DCJS approved defensive tactics instructor who has successfully completed the Defensive Tactics Two Day Refresher Course.

Peace Officer Training Implementation

Basic Course for Peace Officers and Campus Public Safety Officer Course

All training academies and agencies submitting course curricula for approval to conduct any of the above listed basic peace officer trainings that would begin after September 1, 2018 must utilize the new Defensive Tactics and Principles of Control curriculum. Additionally, instruction must be provided by a DCJS approved defensive tactics instructor that has successfully completed the Defensive Tactics Two Day Refresher Course. ***Instructors conducting the annual weapons (baton) in-service must also meet the new instructor requirement by September 1, 2018.***

Defensive Tactics Two Day Refresher Course Offerings

While every effort will be made to accommodate as many academies and agencies as possible to meet this new instructor requirement, first preference will be given to those officers who actively teach defensive tactics for the Basic Course for Police Officers and the Specialized Investigator Police Training Course in order to meet the January 1, 2018 requirement. Based on the cadre of approved instructors that will be established as a result of the series of DCJS hosted courses outline below, DCJS will evaluate the need to offer additional courses in 2018 to further support the implementation of the new defensive tactics curriculum in peace officer training by September 1, 2018.

Due to the hands-on nature of this training, seating will be limited. To aid in the task of reaching all qualified defensive tactics instructors in New York State and maximize limited seating, DCJS asks that you submit registrations for your academy's lead defensive tactics instructors that are currently approved by DCJS. Upon successful completion of the two-day refresher, the

instructors selected by your training group will be provided with the knowledge and materials to return to their academy and/or agency and train the remainder of defensive tactics instructors in their region as needed.

The Defensive Tactics Two Day Refresher Training will be offered in the following locations during 2017.

Schenectady County - November 6-7, 2017

Nassau County – November 13-14, 2017

Onondaga County - November 30-December 1, 2017 ***Oneida County** – December 18-19, 2017*
