On behalf of the Governor's Traffic Safety Committee, I am pleased to notify you that the Warren County Sheriff's Office has been awarded a total of \$18,000 to participate in the statewide Police Traffic Services Program. Our goal is to increase seat belt usage and reduce dangerous driving behaviors in an effort to reduce serious injury and death from traffic crashes. A breakdown of your grant award amount is as follows:

Please note, contracts are with the County, City, Town or Village, not your specific agency. Once the contract has been signed by the New York State Governor's Traffic Safety Committee, one contract will be returned to you for your records.
