AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF INDIGENT LEGAL SERVICES FOR THE SECOND UPDATE MODEL FAMILY REPRESENTATION OFFICE GRANT TO DEVELOP NEW, INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS AND PRACTICES TO IMPROVE THE DELIVERY OF INDIGENT LEGAL SERVICES BY PROVIDING LEGAL REPRESENTATION TO PARENTS IN CHILD PROTECTIVE PROCEEDINGS AND TERMINATION OF PARENTAL RIGHTS PROCEEDINGS FOR THE PUBLIC DEFENDER'S OFFICE

RESOLUTION WITHDRAWN

WHEREAS, the Public Defender is requesting approval to submit a grant application to the New York State Office of Indigent Legal Services for the Second Update Model Family Representation Office Grant to develop new, innovative programs and practices to improve the delivery of indigent legal services by providing legal representation to parents in child protective proceedings under New York Family Court Act, Article 10 and termination of parental rights proceedings under New York Family Court Act, Article 6, in an amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Seventy Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Nine Dollars (\$870,139) per year, for a total amount not to exceed Two Million Six Hundred Ten Thousand Four Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$2,610,417), for a three (3) year term to tentatively commence on October 1, 2021, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Warren County Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, authorized to execute a grant application to the New York State Office of Indigent Legal Services for the Second Update Model Family Representation Office Grant to develop new, innovative programs and practices to improve the delivery of indigent legal services by providing legal representation to parents in child protective proceedings under New York Family Court Act, Article 10 and termination of parental rights proceedings under New York Family Court Act, Article 6, in an amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Seventy Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Nine Dollars (\$870,139) per year, for a total amount not to exceed

Two Million Six Hundred Ten Thousand Four Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$2,610,417), for a three (3) year term to tentatively commence on October 1, 2021, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that upon notification of the grant award the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, authorized to execute the grant agreement as well as any modifications, extensions and/or other necessary documents relative to the aforescribed grant program in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that if any further funding becomes available during the term of this agreement, no further resolution to accept said monies is necessary and the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to execute any documents necessary to receive the additional funds in a form approved by the County Attorney.
