RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS FRASIER, MCDEVITT, CONOVER, HOGAN AND STROUGH

AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF THE GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, BUREAU OF COMMUNITY ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH AND FOOD PROTECTION FOR THE CHILDHOOD LEAD POISONING PREVENTION PROGRAM

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors authorizes renewal of the grant agreement with the New York State Department of Health, Bureau of Community Environmental Health and Food Protection, Empire State Plaza, Corning Tower Building, Room 1395, Albany, New York 12237, (the previous renewal having been authorized by Resolution No. 163 of 2016), for the receipt of grant funds for the continuation of a Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program within Warren County, for an annual amount not to exceed Twenty-Three Thousand One Dollars (\$23,001), for a term commencing retroactive to October 1, 2020 and terminating September 30, 2021, and the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, authorized to execute said grant agreement renewal in the form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, also authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to accept any Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) payments that the County may receive relating to the above-described grant renewal, from time to time, in a form approved by the County Attorney.
