Note: As per Governor Cuomo's Executive Order 202.1: "Article 7 of the Public Officers Law, to the extent necessary to permit any public body to meet and take such actions authorized by the law without permitting in public in-person access to meetings and authorizing such meetings to be held remotely by conference call or similar service, provided that the public has the ability to view or listen to such proceeding and that such meetings are recorded and later transcribed". Supervisors Diamond, Magowan and Shepler were physically present, while Supervisors Braymer and Frasier participated remotely.

Mr. Diamond called the meeting of the Public Safety Committee to order at 12:02 p.m.

Copies of the Sheriff agenda were distributed to those in attendance, those participating remotely accessed the agenda via the Warren County website. A copy of the agenda is on file with the meeting minutes.

Motion was made by Ms. Shepler, seconded by Mrs. Frasier and carried unanimously to approve the minutes of the previous Committee meeting, subject to correction by the Clerk of the Board.

Mr. Diamond advised the only agenda item pertained to a request to approve the Warren County Sheriff Department's Police Reform and Reinvention Plan as discussed at the last Committee meeting.

Following a brief discussion, a motion was made by Mrs. Frasier, seconded by Ms. Shepler and carried unanimously to approve the request and the necessary resolution was authorized for the March 19th Board meeting. *A copy of the resolution request form is on file with the minutes.*

There being no further business to come before the Public Safety Committee, on motion made by Mr. Magowan, seconded by Ms. Shepler and carried unanimously, Mr. Diamond adjourned the meeting at 12:05 p.m.
