RESOLUTION No. 33 OF 2022

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS STROUGH AND MERLINO

WAIVING THE STANDING RULE OF THE BOARD RELATING TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT ALL RESOLUTIONS BE APPROVED THROUGH THE ESTABLISHED COMMITTEE STRUCTURE IN ADVANCE OF A BOARD MEETING IN ORDER TO ENTERTAIN RESOLUTIONS AMENDING THE WARREN COUNTY BUDGET FOR 2022 AND MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 6 of 2021, later amended by Resolution No. 69 of 2021, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Rules of the Board, Section A(5) of which indicates that all resolutions must be approved through the established Committee structure in advance of a Board Meeting, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors refrained from adopting new Rules at their Organizational Meeting held on January 6, 2022 and is therefore operating under the Rules most recently adopted by Resolution No. 69 of 2021, and

WHEREAS, the Board has agreed to consider resolutions amending the Warren County Budget for 2022 and making supplemental appropriations, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors does hereby waive the Standing Rule of the Board relating to the requirements that all resolutions be approved through the established Committee structure in advance of a Board meeting in order to entertain the aforementioned resolutions.
