RESOLUTION No. 36 OF 2022

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS CONOVER AND STROUGH

WAIVING THE STANDING RULE OF THE BOARD RELATING TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT ALL RESOLUTIONS BE APPROVED THROUGH THE ESTABLISHED COMMITTEE STRUCTURE IN ADVANCE OF A BOARD MEETING IN ORDER TO ENTERTAIN RESOLUTIONS REQUESTED BY THE COUNTY ATTORNEY: AUTHORIZING A REPLACEMENT DEED FOR A PARCEL CONVEYED AT THE 1996 PUBLIC ACTION OF PROPERTIES; AUTHORIZING A CORRECTED TAX ROLL FOR 2022 TO CORRECT A CLERICAL ERROR ON THE TAX ROLL FOR A PARCEL IN LAKE LUZERNE; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO APPROVE NEW YORK STATE REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW CORRECTION OF ERRORS AND/OR APPLICATIONS FOR REFUNDS

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 6 of 2021, later amended by Resolution No. 69 of 2021, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Rules of the Board, Section A(5) of which indicates that all resolutions must be approved through the established Committee structure in advance of a Board Meeting, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors refrained from adopting new Rules at their Organizational Meeting held on January 6, 2022 and is therefore operating under the Rules most recently adopted by Resolution No. 69 of 2021, and

WHEREAS, the Board has agreed to consider a resolutions: authorizing a replacement deed for a parcel conveyed at the 1996 public action of properties; authorizing a corrected tax roll for 2022 to correct a clerical error on the tax roll for a parcel in Lake Luzerne; and authorizing the County Auditor to approve New York State Real Property Tax Law correction of errors and/or applications for refunds , now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors does hereby waive the Standing Rule of the Board relating to the requirements that all resolutions be approved through the established Committee structure in advance of a Board meeting in order to entertain the aforementioned resolutions.
