RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS FRASIER, MCDEVITT, HOGAN, BRAYMER, CONOVER, BEATY AND GERACI

AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY SERVICES TO EXECUTE A TWO (2) YEAR LEASE AGREEMENT WITH THE WARREN-WASHINGTON ASSOCIATION FOR MENTAL HEALTH, INC. FOR OFFICE SPACE FOR THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY SERVICES FOR WARREN AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES

WHEREAS, the Office of Community Services is authorized each year to enter into contracts with various agencies and institutions to provide community mental health services pursuant to provisions of the Mental Hygiene Law as demonstrated in Resolution No. 496 of 2018, and

WHEREAS, the Office of Community Services currently leases office space from the Warren-Washington Association for Mental Health, Inc., on an annual basis, and the Director of the Office of Community Services desires to continue leasing the current premises for an additional two (2) year term, commencing on January 1, 2022 and terminating on December 31, 2023, in an annual amount of Thirty Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars and Fifty-Eight Cents (\$30,855.58) for 2022, payable in equal monthly installments of Two Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars and Twenty-Two Cents (\$2,573.22), with a two percent (2%) increase in 2023, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of the Office of Community Services to execute a two (2) year lease agreement with the Warren-Washington Association for Mental Health, Inc., to provide office space for the Office of Community Services for Warren and Washington Counties as described in the preambles above, and be it further

RESOLVED, that funding for the agreement shall be provided from Budget Codes A.9788 610, Leases, Principal-Indebtedness, and A.9788 710, Leases, Interest-Indebtedness.
